Journey north to Minilya, as we make our way to Coral Bay. Being one of the world's largest and accessible coral reefs, fringing on the Ningaloo reef. After lunch, delight in the underwater world as we take a glass bottom boat tour and then depart to Exmouth to the Pot Shot Motel.

Day 7 Exmouth (B/L/D)

We travel to Mullewa, Morawa, and Perenjori to our overnight stay at Dalwallinu Motel.
