Day 1 Monday Mundaring – Meckering - Merredin

Mundaring Weir is where it all began for CY O'Connor when he dreamt of supplying water to the Kalgoorlie gold fields. Pump Station No.1 gives birth to all 560 km of the 'Golden Pipeline'. An indomitable human spirit was an essential ingredient in the creation of a successful community. View the Meckering Earth Quake centre & information park. Remember 1968? Delve into history at the Cunderdin Museum, housed in the original No 3 Pump Station which contains a collection of local artifacts and displays. Overnight: Merredin Motel.

Day 2 Tues Merredin –Kalgoorlie (B/L/D)

Merredin is the largest regional centre in the Eastern Wheatbelt and has a population of around 3000. Start with an early morning tour of Merredin. Discover stories of the Golden Pipeline and visit the Military Museum to discover the role Merredin played during the war years. We visit the Nungarin Heritage Machinery & Army Museum. We make our way through to Westonia, Southern Cross and on to Karalee Rock Water Flume, an amazing water hole originally one of Hunts wells and then a watering point for the workers on the Kalgoorlie pipeline and the trains. On to Coolgardie



and Kalgoorlie where we will stay overnight.

Day 3 Wednesday Kalgoorlie (B/D)

Experience the exciting days of the early gold rush, when men risked their lives to make their fortune in Kalgoorlie. Visit the Super Pit and Mt Charlotte reservoir where the Golden Pipeline delivers its lifesaving water. View beautiful Hamond Park with its bird aviaries and wildlife. In Hay Street we visit Questa Casa Bordello and discover the history of "the ladies of the night". Night tour of Kalgoorlie and Super Pit. Overnight Kalgoorlie

Day 4 Thursday (B/L/D)

Travel North through the historic mining town of Menzies to Lake Ballard. A surreal landscape where the metal statues of 51 residents of an outback town inhabit ten square kilometres of a shimmering salt lake, the lake's brilliant white expanse, dotted with the famous sculptures invokes an instant sense of awe. The town of Leonora honours a niece of Sir John Forrest, Miss Phyllis Leonora Hardey. When Forrest was exploring the region in an 1869 expedition in search of the remains of legendary explorer Ludwig Leichhardt (who had disappeared in 1848), he came across a distinctive conical hill which he named in his niece's honour. Unbeknown to Forrest, this prominent geographic feature was an ancient Aboriginal site of tremendous spiritual significance, including association with the 'dreaming' of the 'Seven Sisters'. Today we visit the Super Pit and explore The Old Power House and walk down to the Boulder Town Hall to see the famous Goatcher Curtain depicting the Bay of Naples which has hung in the Boulder town hall since 1908 and is believed to be the last surviving example of a Philip Goatcher stage curtain in Western Australia. BYO lunch today. We visit the racing museum then do a tour of Kalgoorlie Town Hall before heading back to our Motel. Overnight Kalgoorlie

Day 6 Saturday Kalgoorlie-Hyden (B/L/D)

After breakfast we depart Kalgoorlie for Coolgardie Museum. Coolgardie was mother to one of the world's richest goldfields, now formally registered as a thriving "ghost town". We make our way to the Boorabbin Memorial site for a picnic lunch and then we are off to Hyden. We visit Mulka's Cave which is located within the vicinity of Wave Rock in Hyden WA. The name Mulka comes from an Aboriginal legend associated with the cave. Mulka was the illegal son of a woman who fell in love with a man with whom marriage was forbidden according to their law. Overnight at Hyden Motel.

Day 7 Sunday Hyden-Home (B/L)

After breakfast we tour Wave Rock, which is one of Australia's most famous landforms. This huge giant surf wave of



multi coloured granite feels like its about to crash onto the bush below. Stand under it and feel rock power from over 2,700 million years ago, before dinosaurs roamed the earth. We visit the miniature soldiers collection and the Lace Place and Bridal display. This amazing collection of over 10,000 handmade pieces are displayed in series of the great wars. See soldiers at war in jungles and deserts and the six metre long display of the 1953 Coronation of Queen Elizabeth II. See soldiers at battle in jungles and deserts with miniature tanks and guns. This amazing display includes the Napoleonic War, the American Civil War, the Zulu War, the Pacific War, the Russian War, World War 1 and World War 2. Please enjoy the work of Alex Smith's life long love.

We depart for a Farm Machinery Tour and Lunch. After lunch we leave for home via the wonderful Tin Horse Highway. There are currently over 70 tin horses displayed on the Tin Horse Highway, in the townsite of Kulin and along other roads to Kulin.

Visit Holy Trinity Church, completed in 1854. The church also contains a rare Albert Piesse pipe organ with eight bells. Overnight at Northam Motel.

Day 2 Northam – Home (B)

Rise and shine for all those Balloonists brave enough to head up into the clouds. On landing, you will enjoy a champagne breakfast and be awarded with your Balloonatics Certificate. For those not ballooning, sleep in before taking in the delights of Northam. Toodyay Emporium is a collector's delight. Free time in historic Toodyay, steeped in Moondyne Joe history. Visit one of the largest Christmas shops in the main street. BYO lunch before departing homeward bound.
